J U D G M E N T

Writ petitioners 1 to 3 in W.P.(C) No.14713/2006 had joined duty on 02/05/2006, 03/05/2006 and 03/05/2006, respectively, as II-Grade Technician (Refrigeration and General Mechanic), appointed by the Thiruvananthapuram Regional Co-operative Milk Producer's Union Ltd., in short 'MILMA'.

2. Writ petitioners 1 to 4 in W.P.(C) No.15770/2006 are rank holders 1 to 4, as per the list accepted by MILMA, in their resolution No.162, dated 08/03/2006, as Technician Grade-II (Electrician-General). Though, three persons, as stated above, have joined duty, the rank holders 1 to 4, could not join, as the Director, Dairy Development Department, Thiruvananthapuram, in short 'the Director', through his order dated 12/05/2006, temporarily set aside the list and further directed that anyone who were appointed by MILMA, should be removed from the post and the compliance be reported to the Director, within 10 days from the date of issue of the order. Therefore, through

these separate writ petitions, the writ petitioners came before this Court to quash the order dated 12/05/2006 of the Director.

3. I have heard the arguments advanced by the learned counsel for the writ petitioners, Mr.K.Anand for MILMA, the Senior Government Pleader for the State as well as the Director.

4. In the order dated 12/05/2006, the Director, had temporarily set aside the appointments made by MILMA on 18/02/2006, due to the improper conducting of the tests. It was also directed to remove the persons, who were already appointed. The order passed being temporary, the matter is still pending with the Director. The facts stated in the order dated 12/05/2006 of the Director, reveal some improprieties, in conducting the practical test and interview of the candidates, who have been selected and listed as per the rank, by MILMA. Therefore, it is within the competency of the Director of Dairy Development, to examine the matter fully and thoroughly and pass final orders.

5. There is a submission by the learned counsel for the writ petitioners in W.P.(C) No.15770/2006, that despite having placed in rank Nos. 1 to 4 of the list published by MILMA and the appointment of three other persons, from another category of the same list, without appointing of petitioners 1 to 4, is causing lot of heart-burn and discontentment among the writ petitioners. Therefore, the learned counsel prayed that the petitioners 1 to 4 may also be appointed, as that of writ petitioners in W.P.(C) No.14713/2006, and the writ petitioners 1 to 4 are prepared to abide by any decision that may be taken by the Director.

6. In the above facts situation, without entering into any discussions on the merit of the matter, I set aside the order No.C1/5401/2006, dated 12/05/2006 of the Director. The writ petitioners 1 to 4 in W.P.(C) No.15770/2006, shall be appointed within one week from the date of production of the copy of this judgment. The Director shall hear the writ petitioners in both the writ petitions, the Managing Director of MILMA and all others, those who are connected with this matter

and pass appropriate orders, within six weeks from the date of production of the judgment.

7. The appointment of the writ petitioners in both these writ petitions as well as the rank list prepared for appointment in MILMA, shall be subject to the consideration and final decision of the Director of Dairy Development Department, Thiruvananthapuram.
